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Dear Craig,

I hope you had a good week-end.

I have attached our preliminary codings {there will be stray typos etc in the typed sections. It's really a work-in-progress document hence some of its rudimentary descriptions of cases}.

I have used the suffix 1.2 at the end to differentiate it from previous version.

I just updated the three cases (we) academics disagreed on.

To be honest and transparent – our team are still really struggling with the cases involving paedophilia. The academic literature is marked by disagreement. Some argue that if paedophilia is motive at play then this should NOT be classed as a BIAS crime [logic is that paedophilia is a crime – victims not deserving of categorisation] but to the extent that some perpetrators equate paedophilia with homosexuality (despite flaw with such a conflation) then that makes me think that BIAS should be accounted for.

I guess it all goes to whether Parrabell is framed as *purely being about anti-homosexual sentiment* (which it appears to explicitly and implicitly be).

In any sense – despite months of thinking and deliberating – we are struggling to delineate a definitional line in the sand (if that makes sense).

So, I think the disagreement number runs to 20 odd cases. 99% of which cluster in the top of the EXCEL sheet.

Maybe we can get somewhere (as a group) on Friday in terms of consensus about this vexatious issue of the way that paedophilia might/should be accounted for in this process.

Wish I could report this task is getting easier. It's the most challenging task I have ever undertaken. It's so important to "get it right" but also so hard to do so!

Still, looking forward to a frank and fruitful discussion on Friday.
