Just confirming what spreadsheet you were after?

Michael made mention to a spreadsheet a couple of times as well however I really don't know what he is talking about? When we met initially, I had a spreadsheet that was prepared by Derek Dolton and his team but I am not prepared to release that and it won't be of any assistance to anyone anyway.

I initially created a spreadsheet when I started Parrabell so that I had a 'master list' of all the victim names and the basic information that was handed to me by the Bias Crimes Unit - this spreadsheet details the information (and spelling) that was originally prepared by Thompson and Tomsen. I started to update it as Parrabell progressed when there were glaring inconsistencies in the information that was originally provided and what I was finding when reading through the case file items.

This 'master' spreadsheet is no way entirely accurate or complete and I don't really want that to be released to anyone as it isn't accurate. The only thing that it is used for now is to identify a victim name with a case number for the purpose of the report numbers.

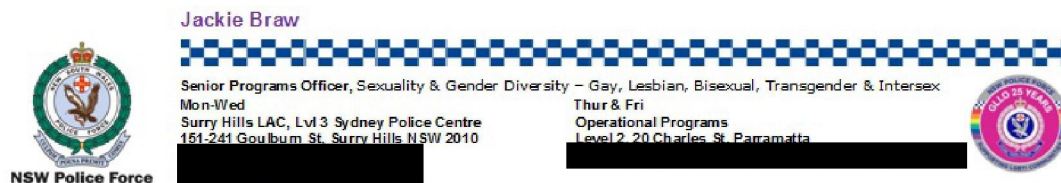
Hi Michael,
