Nicole Asquith gave me your name and suggested you may be interested in submitting a proposal.

We have been conducting a NSWPF 'review' of a number of homicides during the late 70s-90s in NSW in response to significant community concern and media attention, particularly focussing on the death of Scott Johnson.

Whilst we are not looking at this case as it is the subject of a new inquest, we are reviewing 88 others. A media story about the work of the Strikeforce thus far can be found here:

We think it would be most valuable to seek an independent, qualified 'assessment' or evaluation if you like, of the Strikeforce's approach and results.

Exactly how this evaluation is completed is up to you, but we expect the following to be included:

- An independent evaluation of Strikeforce Parabell's (SP) review of the identified 88 deaths during the late 70s,
 80s and 90s
- An examination of the process and method used to conduct SP including the application of NSWPF Bias Crime indicators
- Access and review original source materials as needed
- Research and provide an introductory section detailing the historical context of policing during this period and a commentary on investigating deaths of men identified as gay or transgender during this period
- Provide a conclusion including comment on the efficacy and quality of SP's review, the outcomes of the review, does the researcher agree with SP outcomes/determinations?
- Provide recommendations for future policing, community engagement, training, development of bias crime indicators/processes
- Provide relevant recommendations for future directions of the GLLO program

- Produce and publish a research article
- Throughout this entire process maintain close contact with the Corporate Sponsor Sexuality & Gender Diversity and the Senior Programs Officer (S&GD)
