When a new strike force is formed, the Terms of reference issued by the Serious Crime Directorate require the investigator (normally the supervisor) to make contact with this office (within 14 days of receiving the terms of reference) and arrange what is known as an initial legal conference. Once the conference (basically a quick discussion of the new investigation) takes place, the legal officer produces a document known as the 'ICON' (Initial Conference) which is then uploaded on Eaglel and saved as an Investigator Note.

This is a requirement imposed by the SCC.

Because of the homogeneous nature of the matters investigated by the Squad (this does not in any way reflect on the complexity or otherwise of murder investigations), I can facilitate compliance with the SCC requirement

by completing the 'ICON' ex-parte, so long as there is an Investigation plan is in existence which outlines the details of the investigation.

Having said that, of course I am always available to assist in these as well other matters in person or by phone, email etc..
