As discussed please start making arrangements to gain access to the 3 matters encompassing Taradale (Mittaini, Russell, Warren) with the UHT. I believe that these matters should be housed at UHT? given that they are unsolved and previously 'active'. If you meet resistance please let me know as its my understanding that DSupt Willing has now requested that we review these matters.

 * Volume of material for each matter?
 * Taradale reinvestigation? where, volume of material?

Once I know what we are in for I can decide on resources and advise Mr Crandell of a timeframe.
