I was present at the State Coroners Court with Detective Sergeant Penny Brown and Detective Senior Constable Rowena Clancy yesterday when the findings were read out.

Both Penny and Rowena have done a fantastic job on the Strike Force Macnamir case over the past four years despite significant pressures and difficulties. I think they were more stunned then anything else with the result as we all were, but understandably both girls became pretty upset thereafter.

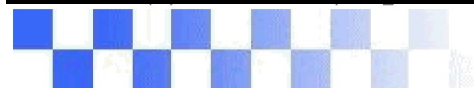
Immediately following the inquest finding a meeting was held at the Coroners Court with the CoP legal representative at inquest Ms Sarah Pritchard SC of Forbes Chambers and Instructing Solicitor Elena of Ashurst Lawyers. [REDACTED] but went out of her way to praise both Penny and Rowena in my presence for their hard work, dedication, commitment, and integrity on this challenging case and reiterated they have much to be proud of which I concur.

Jason Dickinson and I sat down with both of them yesterday afternoon upon return from court to debrief, reassure and compliment them.

I am having a debrief with the Penny and Rowena and team today for a UHT Christmas lunch nearby so all good.
