- DCI Pam Young did express some personal views during last night's interview, but the majority of points she raised are contained within her statement provided to the Coroner.
- Pam is an experienced and talented detective with almost 30 years experience - 16 of those in Homicide.
- Pam has led an extensive and methodical two-year investigation into all the circumstances surrounding Scott Johnson's death.
- During that time, her work has come under intense scrutiny and pressure from outside of the police, including personal attacks on her and other members of her team.
- We wrote to the Coroner last year seeking a re-examination of Scott's death. We welcome the third inquest.
