I feel this about you, Jubelin, Russell, and Andy. That feeling was an intangible presence coming up to and during the Lateline interview. The support from the 'troop' level, some I don't even know from other States, has been humbling, overwhelming, and keeps coming. HVSG are also on board, to name a few.

What was tangible was the fear I could smell from the management subsequently. The way they ducked around what they had approved was truly impressive. It was very tough early last week, and I have to say that the option of falling off the perch flashed before me at the point when I was told that management were going to publish that my comments were "inopportune". NK sent me (from Paris) some very encouraging words which saved me on that day. It of course was NK who I referred to on Lateline as the DCoP who was shocked when he learned, after the event, that the Minister had called us to a meeting with the NOK.

Now, my determination is even more crystalised. We are the voice of those who are dead and cannot speak for themselves after all, even if those who are married to the police 'machine' have not heard of such principles.

I read 'The Good Cop' article when it came out and the quality came through in bucket loads. Can't believe that AS has today announced his inclination to stay on! It will be even more of a show down for the supporters of the contenders to each show their hand more effectively. I hope NK is taking it okay.

Wow, I'd love to speak with Yana most especially about her stellar career and challenges. It's a sign of the loss-of-control-panic that a couple of days back I was given a written direction not to have contact with any media on the Johnson topic. As my redacted statements have been made public by the State Coroner, Yana may be interested in making her way through those? as there may be a time in the future when the dust settles and we could talk. I will look forward to such an opportunity and I hope you are in a position to pass on my response.

What bought all of these very recent developments to my attention whilst off line, was I got a call from Yana Wendt, she had recently written a major story on Nick Kaldas for the Good Weekend of which she interviewed me and I became a small part of the story. She had my contact details from that and rang me, yesterday.

She's very impressed with you, obviously has been following the media about it, I indicated my strong views on you but advised that I knew little about this actual case other than what had been in the media, (that I'd left Homicide in 2005 etc),

She indicated she would like to just talk to you, I think she's scoping. I told her I'd not provide your contact details – she understood and gave me a email address which is [REDACTED], so you could initiate contact with her if you wish. I believe she freelancers now.

Anyway championess the most important thing is that you know there are plenty of us out there who are proud of your stance on this and are thinking of you, remember please don't hesitate to call anytime about anything.
