- This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.
- 2. On Saturday the 6th of May, 1989 I was rostered to perform Station Duties at the Kings Cross Police Station between the hours of 7am and $3.30p_{\overline{m}}$.
- 3. Shortly before 1pm I was standing at the Inquiry Counter at the Kings Cross Police Station when a male person, by the name of Bill St.John entered the station and told me somethin As a result of what I was told by St.John I went downstairs to the Detectives Office and had a conversation with Detective Senior Constable SCULLION.
- Detective SCULLION and I then went with St. John to a block of units on the corner of Greenknowe Ave and Baroda St. St. John then showed us to unit No On arrival at this unit I noticed that the front door was slightly ajar. Detective SCULLION and I entered the unit, which was a small Batchelor type unit. On entering the unit I observed a male person lying face down on a double bed to the left of the front door. I observed that the male person had a pillow case over his head and a leather strap around his neck, through the leather strap, at the rear of his head was a silver pair of kitchen tongs which had been turned to twist the leather strap, tightening it around the neck of the male person. I also noticed pieces of a ceramic pot on the bed around the male persons head.

- 5. I then noticed that the male persons hand were tied behind his back with cord and that his feet were also bound with a similar cord. The male person appeared deceased.
- 6. Inside the unit I also noticed that a small radiator heater was on and that the television was on.
- 7. Detective Scullion and I then left the room and after a short conversation with him, I returned to Kings Cross Police Station where I had a conversation with Detective Sergeant SPAIN. Sergeant SPAIN and I then returned to the unit where I remained for a short time before returning to Kings Cross Police Station and resuming my normal duties.
