During this time, I have gained considerable experience in the Science of Fingerprints. I am also the holder of a Certificate of Expertise in the Science of Fingerprints.

On Saturday the 6 May, 1989, in company with Constable 1/C DEAN; also of the New South Wales Fingerprint Section, Parramatta, I attended the premises of John Gordon HUGHES situated at Unit 3rd Floor, Greenknowe Avenue, Potts Point, where I made a fingerprint examination. Identification graphs bearing Case Number N-136562, were placed next to the developed fingerprints, which were then photographed. Fingerprints and palmprints were developed at the following locations:-

- On the exterior surface of the drainpipe outside the Bathroom Window of Unit (Photographs B1,B2,B3,B4).
- On the exterior surface of the drainpipe outside the Bathroom Window of Unit on the 2nd floor (Photographs B5, B6, B7 and B8).
- 3. On the exterior surface of horizontal portion of drainpipe between Units and (between 2nd and 1st floor) (Photograph B9).

On Sunday the 7 May, 1989, in company with Constable 1/C DEAN, I attended the same premises where I made a further fingerprint examination. Identification graphs bearing Case Number N-136562, were placed next to the developed fingerprints and palmprints, which were then photographed. Fingerprints and palmprints were developed at the following locations:-

- 5. On interior surface of tile wall near edge of window surround of Bathroom of Unit (Photographs B11 and B12).
- On interior surface of window sill of Bathroom of Unit (Photograph B13).
- 7. On side surface of ceramic smoking implement on coffee table (Photograph B14)

The following exhibits were taken back to the New South Wales Fingerprint Section, Parramatta for further fingerprint examination:-1 x Timber Peg Memo Holder.

- 1 x Pair of Spectacles.
- 1 x Red Lamp Base With Pearl Lightglobe.
- 1 x Brown and Orange Lamp With Blue Lightglobe.

A fingerprint was developed on the exterior surface of a Pearl Lightglobe. An identification graph bearing the Case Number N-136562, was placed next to the developed fingerprint and then photographed (Photograph B).

On the 2 May, 1990, a set of fingerprints bearing the name of Ian Stuart JONES, were received at the New South Wales Fingerprint Section, Parramatta. This set of fingerprints were shown to have been taken at the Sydney Police Centre on the 30 April, 1990, by Constable Andrew MCGRATH.

I have carefully compared the fingerprints and palmprints appearing in the photographs bearing identification graph Case Number N-136562, with the fingerprint and palmprint impressions appearing on the
