

Special Commission of Inquiry into LGBTIQ hate crimes Statement of Terry Forster

This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence that I would be prepared, if necessary, to give to the Special Commission of Inquiry into LGBTIQ hate crimes ("the Inquiry") as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief.

- 1. My name is Terry Forster.
- 2. I was born in 1948. My address is known to the Special Commission of Inquiry ("the Inquiry").

Relationship to Russell Payne

- 3. I was formerly married to Julie Kilgour, Russell Payne's sister, and knew Russell well. I was married to Julie Kilgour in the early 1970s.
- 4. After Julie and I separated, I continued to see Russell regularly, when I travelled to Inverell to do my shopping. This was approximately every fortnight.
- 5. We would meet up in the main street or the park in Inverell. I did not visit Russell's home.
- 6. On one occasion, shortly before his death, Russell told me he was gay.
- 7. He said words to the effect of "Did you know I was gay?" and I told him I didn't.
- 8. I told Russell that I accepted that he was gay, and our friendship continued as it had done previously.
- 9. Russell did not tell me of any partner.
- 10. Russell never discussed any of his sexual practices with me, and never expressed any interest in sado-masochism.
