- 1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.
- 2. My age is 36.
- 3. I have resided at the above premises for a period of three years. During that time I have had very little contact with any of the residents.
- 4. On the 19th November, 1991, I returned home from work at about 8.15pm. After I got home I changed out of my work clothes and put on the television. 'The Investigators' was on Channel 2, (A.B.C.) and while that was on I prepared tea.
- 5. I then turned over to Channel 10 about 8.30pm and commenced to watch 'Equal Justice'. I spent the time watching television and was generally on the go around the unit during commercial breaks.
- 6. At 9.30pm 'L.A. Law' commenced on Channel 10 and again watched television and moved around the unit during the commercial breaks.

during 'Equal Justice' or 'L.A. Law' when I was in the kitchen at the kitchen sink when I heard raised voices, both were male. One was louder and one was softer. The voices sounded like they came from above me in the unit above, directly overhead.

- 8. I couldn't make out the words in the argument but it lasted only a very short time. There were a couple of loud phrases and then I heard a thud. It was like something fairly solid and it appeared to be hitting the floor above. I don't think I remember anything after that.
- 9. I was only in the kitchen during a commercial break and returned to the television after the break. It was during the time in the kitchen that I heard the argument and the thump. I know the sounds of two people having an argument in a flat above me because I lived in London for nine and a half years and I lived in the same building for five years. During that time the couple who resided above me for eighteen months had frequent arguments and generally involved in domestic violence.
- 10. My unit is on the 1st floor. When you get out of the lift you turn left and take the right hand door. As you enter the unit there is a short hallway with a bedroom off to the right. You go straight on into the lounge/dining area and the kitchen is off to the right of that room about two thirds the way down the wall. The unit has a balcony and the door to the balcony is past the kitchen entrance.
- 11. When I am standing at the kitchen sink it only requires me to take two steps to get back to the lounge room.
- 12. When I heard the sounds of the argument and the thud, the thud appeared to be above me in the kitchen of the unit above if it has the same layout. I have never been to the unit above.
