

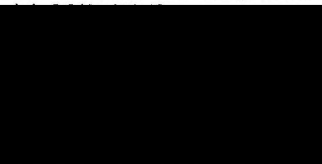

At 10.30am on the 14/09/2010 DSC Hungerford attended Dennis O'Toole's address and spoke to him about this matter. Prior to attending police had emailed him his statement and a copy of the coroners transcript.

Dennis O'Toole stated that he recalled the matter.

It is his belief then and now that the person who killed him was a male prostitute or male pretending to be a prostitute to rob Dutfield.

Whilst Arthur ASHWORTH is listed as a suspect he was never considered as a suspect due to his age and investigators believe it was physically incapable of committing the murder. He stated that he was unaware of the fingerprint of Ashworth being located on the Murder Weapon.

Can not recall if **154** or Ashworth had a beard (male in **163** statement)

Can not recall what happened to the Search Warrant to obtain the phone calls. He knew it was a very important inquiry and can only assume that there was no relevant phone calls that they did not already know about.
