At 11.30am on the 03/11/2010 DSC Hungerford contacted [155] in relation to Arthur ASHWORTH

He advised police that he had first met Arthur ASHWORTH through The Garrison Retirement Village. [155] was a carer working there. He met ASHWORTH about 5 years before his death and became a close friend (not a Homosexual Relationship). ASHWORTH was an elderly male when he met him and kept mainly to himself. He did not keep in regular contact with his family and did not have many freinds. [155] can not recall any other freinds at the time. [155] was in reasonable health when he met him and they traveled overseas together. [155] was a carer/freind on these trips.

[155] stated ASHWORTH had told him about the murder of a freind of his by the name of DUTFIELD however did not talk about any of the details of this matter. [155] stated he could not offer a further information about this death.

He suspected that ASHWORTH was a homosexual male however does not know for sure.

[155] was an executor in the will however did not have much money at the time of his death.
