1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in court as a witness. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false, or do not believe to be true.
2. I am 61 years of age.
3. On the 18 November 2010 I handed to DSC Hungerford of NSW Police an Australia Passport No. [REDACTED] of Arthur ASHWORTH and a personal diary of Arthur ASHWORTH labelled State Super 2003 diary. I have had explained to me that police are going to try to obtain a DNA sample of Arthur ASHWORTH from these two items.
4. I am married to [REDACTED] 179 [REDACTED] 179 is the nephew of Arthur ASHWORTH. [REDACTED] 179 is the son of [REDACTED] who was the sister of Arthur ASHWORTH. [REDACTED] 179 was one of the executors of Arthur's will and retained the passport and diary after his death. [REDACTED] 179 has spoken to police and is also aware of the objects being used for DNA.
