was returned to the coroners Court.

On the 09/12/2011 DSC Hungerford copied the coroners file, statements and photos and

put them on a disk as sent them in internal mail to Sgt MADDOCKS

On the 16/04/2012 DSC Hungerford sent an email to Sgt MADDOCKS to find out if there

was any update in relation to this matter.

On the 26/06/2012 DSC Hungerford spoke to Sgt MADDOCKS from Glebe Prosecutors who

advised police that after reviewing the information and consultation with the Coroner his

advise was that this matter could not be taken any further at the coroners court.

If Ashworth was still alive they would defiantly hold a further inquest however as he is deceased and there are still significant issues outstanding there the coroner would have to return an open finding. There must be sufficient clear and cogent evidence and more on the

balance. There is insufficient evidence for the coroner to name there person Ashworth.

On the 26/06/2012 DSC Hungerford advised Insp Lehmann of this opinion and has stated

on that advice a POA should be completed.
