### Special Commission of Inquiry into LGBTIQ hate crimes

As you are aware, I assist the Honourable Justice John Sackar in the Special Commission of Inquiry into LGBTIQ hate crimes ("the Inquiry").

#### Summons NSWPF31: William Dutfield

Thank you for providing the NSW Police Force ("NSWPF") investigation file in relation to the death of William Dutfield. Having considered the documents provided, the Commissioner would be assisted by further documents relating to the re-investigation of this matter by Strike Force (SF) Hamish as well as the entire fingerprint file held by the NSWPF in relation to this matter.

With the exception of the "Post Operational Assessment" dated 2 October 2013, the documents that have so far been produced in relation to SF Hamish appear to cover a period of time ending in November 2010. The Post-Operational Assessment suggests that the re-investigation was ongoing after that time. The Inquiry would also be assisted by being provided with the fingerprint file relating to Mr Dutfield's death.

To this end, please find **enclosed** a further summons to produce documents to the Inquiry (Summons NSWPF31).

**ANNEXURE TO SUMMONS TO PRODUCE DOCUMENTS**

In this Summons:

**“document”** means the following material held by the NSW Police Force relevant to the death of William Dutfield (DOB: 21/05/1950 and DOD: 19 or 20/11/91):

1. All Strike Force Hamish investigative product from the period 1 December 2010 until 2 December 2013, including:
  - a. All running sheets and surveillance running sheets;
  - b. All occurrence pad entries;
  - c. All criminal incident reports, police incident reports, intelligence reports, crime information reports, “Crimestoppers” reports and Computerised Operational Policing System (“COPS”) event entries;
  - d. All statements and reports made to or by police;
  - e. All police notebook entries;
  - f. All police duty book entries;
  - g. All handwritten notes made by police;
  - h. All photographs, sketch plans and videotapes;
  - i. All results of forensic testing received from DAL or FASS;
  - j. All exhibit book entries; and
  - k. Any recordings (whether audio or video) of interviews, including transcripts thereof.
2. The entire fingerprint file for the investigation of Mr Dutfield’s death.
