My full name is Elizabeth Margret Lloyd-Williams and I reside at _____ and I am a School Teacher by occupation. I am the sister of the deceased David Lloyd-Williams.

The last time I saw David was at about 8.30am on Monday the 22nd August, 1978 when I went around to his flat to make sure he was going to keep his appointment with the Welfare Officer of the A.B.C. at 10.30am that day. I knock on his front door and after awhile David opened the door and when he saw me "He said its Monday already" and then he burst into tears I went inside and he said "There coming to take me away to-day aren't they". I had a conversation with him and then I said I'll put the shower on but he said No, I want to shave first.

I then stayed there for another twenty minutes before I had to leave, he seemed in a very depressed state but there was nothing I could do. I then rang Mrs Worton to see if she could come around and talk to him but I had to leave before she arrived.

David had always been in good health and spirits up until the 1st April, 1978 when his wife then left him and then slowly he seemed to go down hill quickly with fits of depression. He seemed to get worse in the last three weeks as he finally realized that his wife was not going to go back to him.
