## MAN HITS ROCKS IN 200ft DROP

The body of a man was found at the bottom of a 20ft cliff at North Head yesterday.

He was found face down on rocks with blood pouring from a head wound.

Late yesterday police were trying to identify shim.

A car owned by a Mosman man was found at the top of the cliff. The keys were in the ignition.

The body was spotted by Mr Bob Steele, of Yarrawarrah, near Engadine.

"I was looking for a fishing spot when I noticed the man lying on the rocks," he said.

"The water was starting to wash over him.

"I got in touch with the police and then kept an eye on the body."

Police believe the man plunged to the rocks from the top of the cliff.

They are trying to establish whether the man had been reported missing.

A number of other people have died in cliff falls in the same area.

Police have still not traced a woman whose car was discovered at the top of the cliff about four months ago.
