Full Facts: About 10.25pm on the 14 October, 1988, the defendant was spoken to outside the Manly Police Station. At that time he was well effected by a drug. He was searched and on his person was found a Hospital Pharmacy bottle of the Prescribed and restricted drug, Nembudeine, a Schedule 4 drug. The bottle was not of a type issued from a Chemist and no label or evidence of a label indicating that the defendant was the lawful recipient of the drug, was evident. When spoken to about the drugs Source he informed Police that he had bought the drug from a male person in the Manly area on the evening of his arrest. He also informed Police that he had consumed three or four of the tablets about 2 hours prior to his apprehension. (Bottle originally consisted of 50 Tablets - 4 only missing.)

The defendant is well known for this type of offence, and, is a person who can often be found in the Manly and surrounding environs in an overdosed state by utilizing drugs of this type. The Defendant comes from a good family background and has a caring Mother, who, in the past has expressed deep concern for the welfare of this defendant.


The Courts and the Police in the Manly area, have, over the years attempted, on numerous occasions, to guide this defendant away from this type of offence, but, to this stage, no success has been permanently experienced.

Friends of this defendant have in fact died and this fact does not deter him from actions of this kind.

The defendant is a consorter with the local drug element and particularly with a like recidivist named GB. It is evident that once these two keep company both increase their ingestion of prescribed restricted, and, prohibited drugs.

Other than placing this defendant before the Court, Police have exhausted all available means at their disposal by which the defendant, may, in time, have a better future.

Police were of the opinion that the defendant was too well effected to make a statement pertaining to the circumstances surrounding these charges and admissions in conversation between the defendant and Police are relied upon in this matter.
