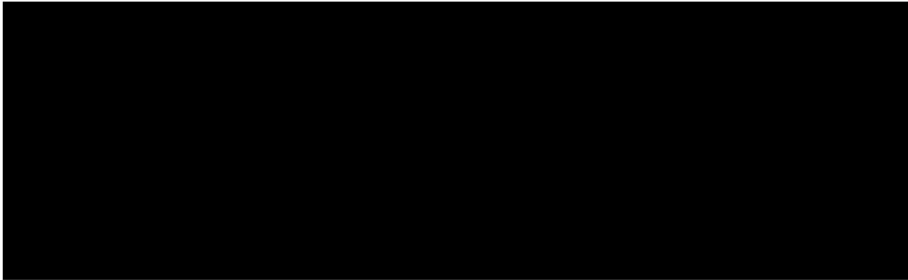
CASE 37: Andrew Ronald CURRIE

CURRIE is listed in Thompson's spreadsheet as having died on 15 December 1989. He was 29 years of age when he was located in Nolan's Reserve Manly, having died from a possible drug overdose.

Investigators have been unable to locate a brief of evidence in relation to this matter. There was also no result from the Ryerson Index or media searches. Mr Lehmann writes in his report that he had a coronial brief of evidence to review. In his report the date of death is listed as 13 December 1988. Through his review of the brief he states that when CURRIE was located there were no signs of violence and that there was a presence of drugs in his body. There was no evidence to suggest that it was a homicide or 'gay hate' related crime.
