1. About 7.15am on Tuesday 13/12/88, I got dropped off by Mrs CURRIE, next to MacKellar Girls Highschool. (Campbell Pde, Manly Vale, approx, 400 meters from where deceased found). I then checked the toilets next to the Bowling Club then came here, (toilet block where deceased found) and found him. I found him face down in a small amount of water on the ground. I then turned him over, checked heart and pulse and then picked him up in a seated position, by under his arms, I then put him back down face up. I felt that his skin felt cold and clammy.

2. I came out and washed my hands at the tap at the front and then went to Pittwater Road where his mother was waiting and told her he 'was'nt coming back, his dead.' Before I went over, I went inside the toilets again as I didn't know what to tell his mother when I saw her. After telling her we got back into the car and went to the Police Station.

3. When I turned him over I saw what I thought was mud on his face.
