SYNOPSIS OF CLINICAL NOTES

- A. History - including relevant past history.
- brought to hospital by.
- Patient found by missionbeat + brought to Campbell House intoxicated. Became drowsy + vomiting ∴ brought to Sydney Hospital by ambulance. CT head showed evidence of gross head trauma ∴ transferred to St Vincents Hospital.
- B. Examination on admission - including evidence of injuries, alcoholic consumption, or other relevant clinical findings.
- initial examination : GCS 12/15, inebriated. + vomiting
retrograde amnesia
Ⓢ periorbital haematoma
fractured R. clavicle
- C. Subsequent progress:
rapid deterioration in neurological status → GCS ↓ 3/15 ± fixed dilated pupils
- D. Treatment: initially taken to theatre for placement of Extraventricular drain.
returned to theatre ± gross brain swelling for skull flap removal
- E. Opinion as to Cause of Death: * head trauma → - fractured skull
- haematomas to brain
- cerebral swelling
- coning.
