SPECIAL CRIME SQUAD:SYNOPSIS21th., May, 1976.UNIDENTIFIED BODY:ManlyNo previous entry

Miss Sheila Patricia CUPITT the receptionist at the Sydney Hilton accompanied Police to the City Morgue and identified the body as a guest of the hotel Mark STEWART. He had been at the hotel since the 9th., May, 1976. *found 11-5-76 10.15am*

The passport found in the possession of the deceased was issued by the British High Commissioner at Canberra. Efforts are being made to have the application to hand as it should reveal the next of kin of the deceased.

The Queensland driver's license in the name of the deceased bore the address [redacted] Upper Edward Street, Brisbane. The premises at this address are a boarding house operated by J Wilson. Brisbane detectives have interviewed Wilson and vide W.M. 2624 advise that the deceased boarded there from Christmas 1975 to the 6-5-76. His antecedents are unknown and it is not know if or where he was employed. Inquiries continuing from other boarders.

Inquiries reveal that STEWART changed his name from SPENSWICK at the Supreme Court, Brisbane in 1974 and that a firm of solicitors, Crouch and Crouch or Brisbane acted on his behalf. Efforts being made to interview solicitor concerned as to knowledge. Inquiries also being made through Immigration Department.
