1. I am a married woman and I reside at the above address with my husband. I am employed The After Care Association of New South Wales as Supervisor in Charge of Clovelly Flats. I have held this position since the 8th January, 1983.
2. Peter SHIEL was referred to our rehabilitation unit by a Social Worker at the Prince of Wales Hospital Psychiatric Unit and arrived there about the 22nd of March, 1983.
3. During his stay at the flats he responded to care and counselling and appeared to improve in his condition. Peter was suffering from Schizo Affective Disorder and on his admission he was on prescribed medication this being, Lithium Carbonate 400mg morning and evening and Modecate Injection 12.5mg fortnightly.
4. On Wednesday 27th April, 1983 Peter left the flats with me and we travelled by car to the corner of Clovelly Road and Keith where I saw Peter board a bus to go to Randwick to enquire about his pension cheque, and also to attend the Prince of Wales Hospital to see his doctor. I did not see Peter again after that.
5. About 2.00pm on Friday 29 April, 1983 Constable Strange of Randwick Police came to the flats and informed me of the death of Peter, we then went to his room and ascertained a phone number for members of his family and the Police left.
