It would have been about 12 thirty to quarter to one that I was with Tony GALVIN, and Lachlie Norris, and we were walking down Crown Lane in a easterly direction and as we were walking down the lane I was nearest the kerb on the northern side and I saw a bloke laying in the grass area just off the footpath, He was laying in a position that he was to-ward the Charcoal Tavern. I could not actually see how he was laying as far as his arms was, he was just laying there. I made the comment to the others "He's had enough" Tony said " He's doing a Craig"

3. We then continued to walk down the hill, and then went inside to Annabelles. We stayed there until about 2 and then Lachlie and I then left the place and went back up the hill to our car, and then went home.

4. I didn't take much notice when we were going back up the hill and I don't know if that bloke was still there.

5. The area where this bloke was laying was pretty dark and I couldn't see what he was wearing. I didn't really take much notice. I had been drinking a bit and I wasn't interested too much as I thought that he was just having a sleep.

6. I declare that no part of this statement is untrue to my knowledge. I know that it may be used in legal proceedings. It accurately sets out the evidence that I am prepared to give in court as a witness if required.
