
My full name is Terrence William MORROW I am an ambulance Paramedic stationed at Wollongong.

About 8.53am on 14 February, 1986 I was called to rear of L and B Store in Crown Lane Wollongong to a person who had fallen off a roof. On our arrival we found a male person lying approximately three metres between a dwelling and a wall. This patient was found to be restless and disorientated and responding only to stimuli. I noted there was a large pool of blood around the head of the patient. Investigating to where the blood was coming from we found the left ear canal was obstructed with congealed blood. Also blood oozing from the nose. On examination of vital signs his airway breathing and circulation were o'k.

I noticed that there was an abrasion to his left inner arm and bruising to the chest. No abnormalities were detected. The patient was very irritable and made treatment difficult. As a result of my observations I determined the patient was suffering from a fractured skull. I could not find any identification on the patient.

From my observations and opinion I feel the patient had fallen from the wall above landing on his head on the concrete
