My full name is Annette Robyn Lavender. I am Ambulance Officer Stationed at Wollongong.

About 8.53 am on Friday 14 February, 1986 I was called to the rear of L & B Store in Crown Lane, Wollongong, to a person who had fallen from a roof. On arrival there I saw a male person lying at the base of steps unconscious. He was wearing blue jeans and blue collared tee shirt and no identity. Haemorrhage from from left ear canal. Abrasion to left arm medial and right lateral back area. His nose was also bleeding. All the haemorrhage had congealed. There was large amount of congealed blood lying around the upper region of his body. From my observations I determined the male person was suffering from a fractured skull. I also noticed that his right leg was wedged under the down pipe of the toilet.
