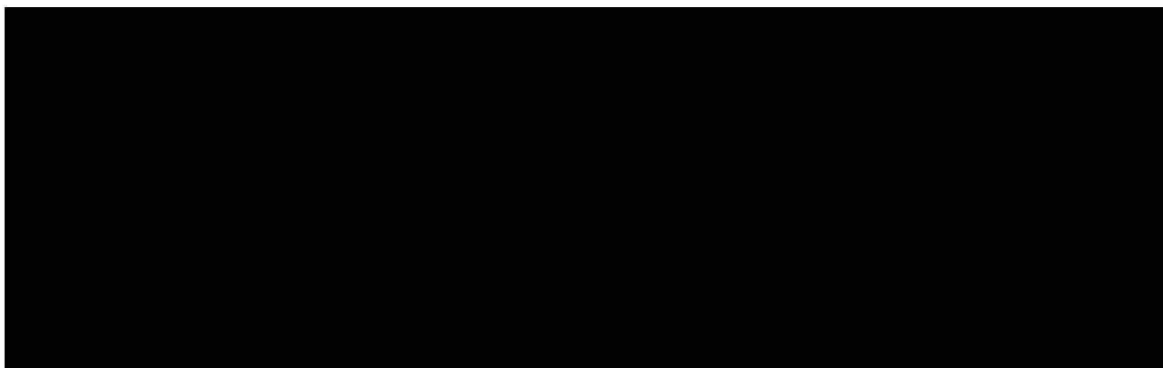


CASE 39: Blair WARK

The date of death is 11 January 1990, when WARK was located in Sydney Harbour with no apparent injuries, wearing jeans, socks and shoes. The rest of his clothing was located at the cliff tops at the Gap. There was an inquest which was dispensed with on 30 July 1990.

Investigators have been unable to locate any brief of evidence for this matter from the Coroners court or State Archives and there is no information on COPS, Ryerson Index or the media. In Mr Lehmann's report he mentions reviewing a Doctor's report and a letter written by the deceased's father.
