1. The accused person was known to me for many years; prior to his arrest, and at the time of his arrest in relation to this matter he was serving a term of Imprisonment at the Cessnock Corrective Centre where his term was to expire on 3rd April, 1983.

2. The accused is a single man 22 years of age and a labourer by occupation. He has informed me that he was born in the Newcastle area and was one of twin boys. His twin brother died of a drug overdose in 1981. He also has a younger sister 20 years of age.

3. The accused has informed me he has lived in the Newcastle area all his life and received his primary and secondary schooling in this area. He left secondary school at the age of 15 years after reaching 3rd form and without obtaining any schooling certificate.

4. On leaving school the accused was unemployed for several months however obtained employment as a labourer with a local chicken processing plant in the Cardiff area. He remained in this employment for only a short period of time and left that employ on his own accord because of medical reasons. He then remained unemployed for several months and during that time received unemployment benefits. He has informed me that since the age of 11 years he has suffered from Asthma and this has restricted his working ability. Since that time the accused has only sought occasional employment in the Newcastle area on a part time basis and has never held any permanent employment since leaving school.

5. The accused person is known to me to be an associate of the criminal and homosexual element both in the Newcastle and Sydney areas, and since the time he left school he has continually been under notice of the police because of his criminal activities.

6. The accused has for several years been residing in temporary accommodation with other persons of his own character and all of whom are well known to police for their criminal, homosexual and drug activities, these persons include, [REDACTED] 1217, [REDACTED]

7. The accused periodically visits his parents in the Newcastle area, but has not permanently resided with his parents for several years.

8. The accused has informed me that he has no sporting interests and is not a member of any organised youth groups or clubs in this area. He has informed that because of his association with the homosexual and transvestite types in this area he became involved in drugs regularly administering various types of drugs which included Ritalin, and Heroin, and other less addictive drugs including Serapax and other nerve stimulant tablets. He also considers himself to be a moderate drinker of Intoxicating Liquor.
