About 9.30pm on 1 September, 1982, I had a conversation with Detective Senior Constable Inkster who handed me a record of interview consisting of six pages.

I then went to an interview room, where I saw the defendant, Jeffrey MILLER. Also present in that room was Senior Constable Wilson. Detective Inkster said to the defendant, "This is Detective Sergeant Parsons, the Officer in Charge of Detectives at Newcastle." I said to the defendant, "I am going to ask you some questions. I want you to understand that you are not obliged to answer them unless you wish. Do you understand that?" He said, "Yes." I said, "Is this a true record of the interview between you and Detective Senior Constable Inkster?" I then showed him a record of interview consisting of 6 pages. He said, "Yes." I said, "Were your answers as recorded in this interview given freely and voluntarily?" He said, "Yes." I said, "Do you have any complaints to make to me about the manner in which this interview was conducted?" He said, "No."

I then endorsed that interview which I returned to Detective Senior Constable Inkster.
