STATES:—

1. I reside at the address stated above and I am currently employed as a commuter pilot with Easter Airways. During the period of time of the 19th December, 1980 I was employed as Service Advisor for Young and Green Pty Ltd at offices situated at King Street, Extended and directly opposite the Birdwood park Toilet block.

2. On that day I can recall that I was working in the office section of Young and Green, reception office and about 1.00pm that day two male persons came to the reception office where I was working and they told me certain things (They told me they had found a man badly injured laying on the floor of the toilet block in Birdwood park) They then requested that I telephone the police and the Ambulance for their attendance at that toilet.

3. I immediately telephoned the Newcastle Police Station and also the Newcastle Ambulance Station and requested these services attend the Birdwood Park Toilet.

4. A short time later these two male persons left the reception area and I believe that one of these male persons was accompanied by a female and they walked back towards the Birdwood Park area.

5. I resumed my normal work in the reception office attending to customers, and a short time later I saw that the Ambulance and Police had arrived at the Birdwood Park Toilet block.
