

## killed for \$30

An elderly pensioner savagely beaten and robbed of his \$30 Christmas shopping money died of his injuries yesterday.

Mr Richard Slater, 69, was attacked in a public lavatory in Newcastle on Friday afternoon, bat-tered about the head and body and left bleeding and unconscious. Mr Slater, of Cooks Hill, had left home on half an hour before to walk to a shopping centre.
