Further to recent contact with the next of kin, Yvonne [REDACTED] (NOK) regarding the unsolved homicide of her maternal grandfather, Richard SLATER and subsequent enquiries completed by Detective Sergeant COSTELLO (see linked IN-3629, IN-3630, BC-118, BC-119)...

On Tuesday 12/12/2017 & 19/12/2017 Detective Sergeant COSTELLO telephoned and left a voice mail message for the NOK. On Wednesday 20/12/2017 Detective COSTELLO was telephoned by the NOK. Detective COSTELLO confirmed with her that the one and only suspect in the murder, Jeffrey MILLER, (who was arrested, charged and committed to stand trial for the murder prior to it being withdrawn by the NSW Attorney General) had indeed died on 01/05/1986 of a suspected drug overdose at his residence.

The NOK was advised as a result of the confirmation of the suspect's death, and due to there being no information available to indicate the involvement of any other POI/suspects, the availability of only limited records/case files and apparently no physical/forensic evidence being retained the investigation is to be suspended. The NOK was advised the investigation would remain inactive but could be re-activated if additional information or evidence became available. The NOK was satisfied with the response and thanked Detective Costello for responding.
