At about 7.20am on the 16th June, 1977, I left my home to go fishing at Fairy Bower. I parked my car in the parking area at Fairy Bower and I was walking south around the base of the cliff when I observed the body of a man wedged between rocks. He was in a sitting position with his head between his legs.

I immediately climbed back up and went to a nearby home and rang the Police. I waited for Senior Constable Parry of Manly Police to arrive and then showed him where the body was. I did not see the deceased fall nor did I see any person in the near vicinity on my arrival.
