SYNOPSIS OF CLINICAL NOTES

(recorded in narrative form to include)

History (including relevant past history)

*Allegedly stabbed x 6 times chest and left arm in coffee shop at Parramatta.
 Unconscious and not responding to pain on arrival.*

Examination on admission (including evidence of injuries, alcoholic consumption or relevant clinical findings).

*10 cm. oblique cut right hypochondrium, lacerating liver and right lung.
 5 cm. deep ragged cut left upper chest (anterior) lacerating lung (haemo-
 pneumothorax.
 4 long slashes down to muscle on left arm.
 Severely hypovolaemic and unconscious on arrival*

Treatment

1. Intubated and ventilated.
2. External cardiac massage
3. Intracardiac adrenalin x 2.
4. Calcium gluconate 10 mls. intravenously.
5. Haemacel pumped by hand continuously (commenced by paramedic)
6. Bilateral chest drains inserted - left chest drain drained 1 litre of blood and froth.

*Attempted resuscitation failed. No cardiac output. Pupils fixed and dilated.
 Life pronounced extinct by me at 2.15 p.m. on the 2nd December, 1980.*

Subsequent progress:

Opinion as to cause of death: *Hypovolaemic shock.*
