Inquest touching the death of Walter John BEDSER.

My full name is John McGregor, I am a Detective Sergeant of Police attached to the Homicide Squad, C.I.B.

At about 1-50 P.M. on 2nd December, 1980, the deceased was seen to run from his antique shop at 4 Darcy Street, Parramatta to a Greengrocers shop owned by Phillip Stephens. At the time, the deceased had a number of severe lacerations to the left arm and a stab wound to the lower chest, and another wound to the left upper chest. The deceased was conveyed to the Parramatta Hospital where he passed away at 2-15 P.M. Life was pronounced extinct by Dr. Older of that Hospital.

The deceased was later identified by Noel John Brown, a bank officer, who had known the deceased for a period of four years. I tender a statement from Mr. Brown. (admitted and marked exhibit ^{TWO} ~~one~~)
 On the 3rd December, the deceased was identified to Dr. Malouf, Government Medical officer who conducted a post mortem examination upon the deceased. I tender a Post-Mortem report under the hand of Dr. Malouf. (admitted and marked exhibit ^{THREE.} ~~two~~)
 At this time, ongoing enquiries are still being made into this matter, numerous persons have been spoken to, and as of this date, there are no suspects.
