 was working in his Artique Shop Which is situate at. 4 Darcy street Parramatta when it is thought a male offender entered his shop and an armuement ensured. Whilst the argument was in progress, passersby herd noises coming from the shop and upon lookirg in through the window, saw Bedser and a male person engaged in a fight. A short time later the offender was seen to run from the shop into Darcy street, celling out to get an ambulance, he then hurried down jarcy Street, crossed hurch street end was last seen walking through st. John's Park' (the grounds surrourding the church).

A short time after he had left the shop, Bedser staggered from the shop
bleeding heavily, he staggered scross the footpath a d collapsed in
a fruit shop about twenty feet from the door of his own shop. The ambulance and Folice were sumoned to the scene. The ambulance officers (Paramedics) revived Bedser however when he ar ived at the Parramatta District Hospital, he was in fact dead. They revived hi ggain, however owing to the eytreme loss of blovd, he eventually died.

We gttended the Parramatta District Hospit? mormue and viewed the body of the deceased. nd it was seen that there were massive gashes to his left arm and body, one wound which was under his right pectoral was obviously caused by a harp knife, the knife apparently punctured the liver and this was no doubt what caused death. The other massive gashes to his arm could heve been caused by the flaying of the knife or lass frow the cabinets within the shop which were broken at the time of the altercation between the deceased and the offender. There was also a stab wound to the upper part of the chest on the left side of the body
Turing the course of the inquiries, it was ascertained that at about 10. ow $2 / 12 / 80$, a man fitting the description of the persor seen running fron Bedser's shop 2bout 2.00 pm , went to Toy World which is in the brcade which is about fifty feet from the shop owned by Bedser, and purchased a sheath knife from a salesgirld, Debbie Faye SMITH. It would appear it this stage that this is the same perso who stabbed Bedser. He paid $\$ 15$ odd dollars for the knife.

It was also learned that the ceceased has homosexual tendancies having been spoken to in 1977 in a park at Parramatta in the company of a man nemed $148 \quad 148$ of wasswell interviewed by Musswellbrok Police 10.30 pm this date audit was learned that he was in his home town 211 day, he is getting over an operation he had at concord General Hospital during the later part of October this year, he does not fit the description of the of enender. however he is a dead set poofter.

The description of the suspect/offender hs Been circulated vide wireless message 35 on 2/12/80 and a message was also circulated directine Police to visit hospitals in their areas so that in the event of any person seeking treatment, the hospitrls could contact their local Police. The reason for this message was that there was a considerable amount of plate glass smashed in the shop and the offender could easily heve cut himself duri g the altercation.

Statements have been obained from a number of witnesses, Det.McVicker of the C.I.U and Rod Amery of the M.O. Section have made a thorough check regarding the deceased and his associates however at this stage the only informatio we have is in re ation to 148 aforementioned.
The Fingerprint Section attended and have developed a number of prints. Det. . gt. Carter of the Prrematta Scientific Bureau conducted a thorough cientific exeminstio of the premises aud surroundine area and carried out hic job correctly.
