1. My full name is Ross Augustus CALKIN, I reside at the above address with my wife and children. I am a Technical Officer with Telcom Australia and I have been employed by them for the past 26 years.
2. Today the 2 December, 1980 I was in an Antique Shop at 4 Darcy Street, Parramatta with my wife Wendy. I am not sure of the time but it was after midday I would say I was around 12.30pm.
3. Just after we had walked into the shop another male person entered the shop and he started looking around the shop. This man was approached by the proprietor and they had a conversation, I don't know what the conversation was about. My wife and I then spoke with the proprietor and asked about the price of a dressing table. My wife and I then left the antique shop with this other male person still in the shop with the proprietor. We didn't purchase anything and continued our shopping.
4. The male person that was still in the shop with the proprietor would be about 45-50 years old, about 5'10" tall, solid build, olive complexion, dark brown hair medium cut, he had side burns down to his ears he also had a slight bridge on his nose. He was wearing light brown zip up cardigan, dark brown slacks and a light coloured shirt. I didn't notice if he had an accent but he could of been Italian. He spoke in a soft voice and I didn't hear what he was saying to the proprietor.
5. I feel I may be able to identify this man if I saw him again. I am prepared to go to Court in this matter if I am required to do so.
