1. I am a married woman and I reside at the above address with my husband and two children.

2. About 12.05-12.10pm today I went with my husband to the Antique Shop in Darcy Street, Parramatta. At that time there was a lady in the shop being served by the owner. They man that was in the shop came in after we had entered the shop and had started to talk to the owner about two particylar pieces of furniture. The man seemed to maintain the owners attention all the time we were in the shop. We had a look at some furniture and then we left the shop, looking at some items in the window of the antique shop both from the Argyle Street side and the arcade.

I would describe this man as being about 45 to 50 old, 5'10" to 5'11" tall, solid build, dark brown hair going grey, olive complexion. He was wearing light coloured shorts, T-shirt or a singlet white and a mid tan coloured cardigan. I am unable to describe this man further.

I am unable to say if I would be able to identify this man again if I saw him.
