- 1. I am a married man and reside at the above address with my wife. I am unemployed at the moment.
- 2. This afternoon I was driving in Darcy Street, Parramatta, when I saw my friend Najib KASSIS standing near his car which was parked in Darcy Street, just down from the antique shop. I stopped my car and spoke with Najib and I had a look at his car. (it was broken down) I then went into the arcade past the antique shop and used a red phone outside one of the shops. I rang the N.R.M.A. After doing this I went back to Najib and stood and waited for the N.R.M.A. to arrive.
- A little later they arrived and then they called for a tow truck over the radio. We waited about one hour and it was about 2pm, the tow truck still had not arrived, when I heard a mans voice call out loudly, "CALL THE POLICE CALL THE AMBULANCE". I noticed that this man had blood on his hands and he seemed to be sweating. Then I heard a scream coming from the antique shop, I ran towards the shop, I saw the guy that got stabbed, he went through the fruit shop and fell down. He was calling out for help.
- 4. Somebody was trying to stop the blood and then the ambulance arrived, then the Police arrived.
- 5. This man that came out of the shop first and had blood on his hands, he was about 6 feet tall, about 30 to 35 years old, big build about 15 stone, he had straight dark brown hair, parted, he was dressed in dark brown shirt long sleeve hanging down, brown coloured trousers, he did not seem to be carrying anything. He ran in the direction of Church Street, and crossed the road towards the park.
