I am a retired person and I reside at the above address with my wife.

I was in Parramatta today on personal business and shortly before two o'clock I was walking down Darcy Street towards Church Street and stopped to look into the Antique Shop at the corner of the Arcade. I heard a couple of loud crashing noises and some shouting, but I couldn't hear what was said, but I wasn't sure whether it was in the shop or coming from the Arcade.

As I was nearly opposite the doorway of the Antique shop, a man ran from the shop and he was holding his chest with a lot of blood coming from it, I think he was yelling 'Help me'. Immediately behind him was another man and he was calling out 'Get an Ambulance'. The first man with blood coming from his chest, staggered around the front of the arcade and into the fruit shop and fell to his knees. The second man hesitated for a few seconds and he was still calling out 'Get an Ambulance' and then he ran down Darcy Street towards the end and I lost sight of him.

I looked over to the injured man and I could see blood everywhere and I started to feel sick. Then some other person came into the shop and started to give him assistance. I then went over and sat on the bus seat and waited to the Police arrived and then had a conversation with them.

I would describe the second man who ran from the shop as being about thirtyish, solid build, about 5'10" tall, brownish hair and wearing a light coloured shirt or jacket, darker coloured trousers.

I didn't take too much notice of this person as I thought he had just come from the shop trying to help the first man.
