He further indicated that his son was only of short stature but message was left for [1267] to contact this office A.M. on 3.12.80.</p>	
	<p>Then attended [redacted] & spoke to Mrs. [redacted] NP59 re son NP58 D.O.B. [redacted]. This young person was apparently an associate of the deceased, Bedser but was not able to be spoke to due to his absence from the premises. Arrangements made for him to contact this office P.M. on the 3.12.80. Information had been received from Mr. Ross THOMPSON of [redacted] tele. number [redacted] (home) [redacted] (work) that BEDSER had financed [redacted] NP58 for the purchase of a motor vehicle which was subsequently stolen and burnt out under suspicious circumstances.
