1. My full name is Steven John STREET, I reside at the above address with my friend Greg Cregan. I am presently employed by W. Stephenson as a contract driver.
2. About 6.20am on Tuesday the 2 December, 1980 I picked up a parcel to be delivered to the Antique Shop No 2 Darcy Street, Parramatta from Royal Doulton warehouse, Gordon.
3. About 2pm that day I stopped my motor vehicle No. _____ outside the front of the Antique shop and stepped into the shop with the parcel. A person I know to be the owner of the fruit shop next door grabbed me on the shoulder and told me something. I then handed the parcel to him and he signed for it.
4. As I was leaving the Antique shop I saw a male person on the floor of the green grocer shop bleeding. I hopped into my truck as the Ambulance arrived and drove off.
5. I didn't see any person in the antique shop nor did I see any person running from the shop.
