- 1. My full name is Gwenn NOBLETT and I reside at the above address with my husband. I am sixty four years old and I am in receipt of the pension.
- 2. On Monday the 1 December, 1980 I was in the Antique Shop at No 4 Darcy Street, Parramatta, at about 3.10pm. I followed a male person as I entered the shop. I started looking around the shop and so did this man. He then went and had a conversation with the owner and I kepted looking around the shop. The man said to Mr. Bedser, "Your a bit pricy." " You know how to put the price on." Mr. Bedser then said, " I don't know about, it's fair enough." Mr. Bedser also said, "There's more about if you like."
- 3. I then went up and had a conversation with Mr. Bedser I purchased some property for about \$25.00 then left the shop. I am not sue if the man was still in the shop or not when I left.
- 4. I describe this man to be about 45 to 50 old, I don't think he had an accent, about 5'9" to 5' 10" tall, solid build, med comp, dark hair going grey med cut he seem to have a straight bone structure, clean shaven,. He was wearing a pale blue shirt I think he had a very fine pencil stripe, short sleeved or sleeves rolled back, dark trousers with a belt, he was clean and neatly dressed.
- 5. I think I might be able to recognize this person if I saw him again.
