	<p>On the 4.12.80 interviewed Raymond Morris HADLEY, of [REDACTED], at his employment at I. Steer & Co. Pty. Ltd., [REDACTED] HADLEY was previously interviewed on the 2.12.80 and a statement taken from him respecting a person answering the suspects description that had gone to the auction rooms about 12.30pm on the 2.12.80.</p>	
	<p>HADLEY stated that as far as he can recollect about 12.45pm on the 2.12.80 the man described in his statement had entered the auction rooms and spoken to him. He stated that the man looked agitated. He said to HADLEY, "I've got a lounge suite and I want to sell it." HADLEY said, "What is it." The man said, "A wing arm." (This is a style of lounge suite and has a high back and is a heavy, well made suite. The wing arm is taken from the shape of the arms of the lounge and also because at the top of each chair there is a 'wing' shape on each side.) HADLEY said, "What are you looking for?" The man said, "The antique dealer has had a look at it and he's offered me \$350.00." HADLEY said, "Go and grab it." The man then grunted and walked out of the premises. He described the man as 30 to 35, 6/0 to 6/1, medium to solid build, about 14 stone, fair hair which may have been dyed, brown eyes, fair complexion, wearing a light coloured short sleeved safari jacket, possibly beige colour, which appeared to have a fleck in the material, dark brown trousers. He could offer no further information in addition to that contained in his original statement.</p>	
	<p>HADLEY further stated that although BEDSER had dealt at the auctions buying goods, he was not considered to be a regular customer. It is known that BEDSER attended auctions at Raffer & Kellaher, Mallett Street, Camperdown, and W. Ellenden, Wentworth Avenue, Sydney.</p>
