	<p>On the 8.12.80 at the Parramatta Police Station further interviewed NP59, [redacted] of [redacted]. Employed by Lenehaul Equipment, 5-7 Saville Street, Villawood.</p>	
	<p>NP58 further stated that whilst he was working for the deceased he went to a number of Auctions with the deceased. These being at Raffan and Kelaher, Larkin Street, Camperdown and Ellenden Auctions in the City. He stated that he stole a chain from the deceased about 18 months ago, and tried to sell the chain at school. The deceased became aware of the stolen chain and he told NP58's mother. NP58 returned the chain to the deceased and apologised to him. Nothing further was ever done about the chain. The main Auction that NP59 attended with the deceased was at Steers, Hassal Street, Parramatta.</p>	
	<p>NP58 stated that the deceased did not have any girlfriends to his knowledge, the only girl to visit the shop was [redacted] and she only called and said hello. NP58 also stated that the deceased was friendly with his mother and Sister. NP58 made a number of country trips with the deceased. Most of these trips they would stay over night. On these trips they would stay in Motels sharing the same rooms. These trips were mainly made to Singleton, Tamworth, Bathurst, Orange, Dubbo and Canberra. On these trips they would see Auctioneers and also Private buyers. NP58 stated that about 8 months ago the deceased and himself tried smoking Marijuana, however NP58 didn't like it and hasn't smoked it since.</p>	<p>See Abs. 464 re ACT deals.</p>
	<p>NP58 and the deceased had a relationship whilst NP58 was working for him. NP58 stated that the deceased would only Masterbate him and that intercourse never took place. The deceased told NP58 that prior to meeting him he use to do the 'beats,' in the parks around Parramatta. NP58 stated that he deceased mentioned the park heading west in Marsden Street, across bridge, first turn on right and the park on the right</p>

	<p>Hand side. He also went to Doyles grounds, near NP58's place. The deceased told NP58 that he never went to these places since he had known NP58. However NP58 believed that the deceased might have returned to these places after they had broken up.</p>	
	<p>NP58 also stated that the deceased had friends who were drag queens that worked at Le Girls up the Cross. The deceased wanted NP58 to come with him and meet these persons, NP58 refused. NP58 stated that the persons names were ' [redacted] ' and ' [redacted] '. The deceased said that he had known these person for ages and they had had sex change operations.</p>	
	<p>The deceased also talk NP58 that he had used the name of John SKINNER on occasions before he met him, but he didnot elaborate on this name.</p>	
	<p>NP58 was questioned as to any other persons who might visit the shop regularly or friends of the deceased. NP58 stated that about 12 months ago a big fat bloke whom he describes as : Male, 25-27 old, 5'10", fair complexion, brown hair, fat build, always wore loose fitting clothing, came into the shop and talked to the deceased. He returned on a number of occasions whilst NP58 worked there and would always go into the office with the deceased and have coffee and talk. The deceased told NP58 that this man was a 'Poofter' and NP58 also formed this opinion by the way the man spoke and also his dress. This person also wore beads around his neck and bangles on his wrists.</p>	
	<p>NP58 further stated that a man from the Psychiatric Centre up near Parramatta Gaol, this man lived with another man. This man use to come and visit the deceased in the shop on numerous occasions and would have coffee with the deceased. NP58 described this man as : Male, 21-22 old, straight black shoulder length hair, 5'9" - 5'10". maybe English & medium build, always well dressed and wore mostly suits.</p>

	<p>FURTHER INTERVIEW WITH NP58 NP58 CONTINUED.....2.</p> <p>NP58 was further interviewed as to the deceased's activities at night. However he could not assist in this aspect. The stated that the deceased didnot attend disco's or snooker rooms with him.</p> <p>NP58 stated that when he first met the deceased, the deceased owned a brown Falcon, he traded this vehi vehicle in at Sinclair Fords, Penrith and bought the Blue Falcon Station Wagon, which he used for his trips to the Country. About 12months ago the deceased bought an OLDER 5000 Torana, Red in Colour from Hulcraft Motors, Church Street, Parramatta, the deceased paid \$10,000 for this vehicle and paid by cheque. About 4 months later he sold the Torana to a dealer in Homebush that deals in Torana's, for \$8,500. The deceased then purchased a Mercury from American Cars, in Parramatta Road, Granville, near, Bold Street overpass. the deceased paid \$13,500.00 for this vehicle. About 3 months later the deceased traded this vehicle in for a Pontiac Sedan, the Pontiac was worth \$22,000.00. The deceased also traded a ring in on this vehicle.</p> <p>NP58 is unaware how much balance the deceased paid for this vehicle. During the purchases of these vehicles the deceased consulted NP58 as to which vehicles he should buy.</p> <p>About 3 months ago the deceased and NP58 had an argument over a vehicle that the deceased was going to lend NP58 some money to purchase. NP58 and the deceased had a falling out in front of NP58's home and NP58 told the deceased to 'Piss Off.'
