	<p>On the 8.12.80 at the Parramatta Police Station, interviewed [1200] [1200], born [redacted] of [redacted], at present attending Granville Technical College doing a Pathology Course.</p>	
	<p>[1200] stated that at the beginning of 1979, her brother [147] started working for the deceased in his Antique Shop. The deceased came to their place on a number of occasions to pick [147] up. [1200] stated that she became friends with the deceased as she would go into the shop on her way home from Tebb to see her brother. She would have conversations with the deceased. She stated that the deceased never made advances towards her. She stated that she has not seen the deceased since her brother's birthday on the [redacted] 80. On this occasion she called into the shop to see [147]. Whilst there she asked the deceased if he was going to come to [147]'s birthday party at the Tavern. The deceased said he might attend, however he never went. She stated that at times that she went to the shop she saw a number of young school children hanging around the shop of both sexes. The Boys were from Marist Brothers and the Girls from Catherine McCauley Schools.</p>	
	<p>About 1 month ago, either the deceased or his sister Shirley told her that the shop had been sold to Shirley and that the deceased was only working there a couple of days per week.</p>	
	<p>On Tuesday, 2.12.80, [1200] went with her brother and another friend, [redacted] of [redacted] to Harman Industries, North Ryde with a steric to be repaired. They then went to Saloniki Jewellery Store, Marrickville Road, Marrickville, about a watch. they then returned to North Ryde, picked up the steric and went home. [1200] could offer no more assistance with this inquiry.</p>
