	<p>Interviewed Mrs Edna BEDSER, mother of deceased. (over and over again)</p> <p>Stated her son would usually come home from work about 6pm each night. Watch the Channel 2 news to-gether and then go to his room and do his books for the shop.</p> <p>On week ends he would pick up I35 and take him to the shop to move articles or deliver goods.</p> <p>The date cannot be remembered but the deceased did go to a bar he que at NP58 place one week end. Mrs Bedser did not like NP58's mother she thought she was bad, she was not to keen on NP58 either. She would not have that the deceased was a poof, some months back he told his mother that he had an american girl friend and he would bring her home to meet mother.</p> <p>Mrs Bedser won \$60,000 in the lottery last year see gave \$20,000 to the deceased and her daughter Shirley Driscoll. The deceased was interested in buying an old home, but his mother did not want him to buy it as he would have to mortgage her home and the one he owns, next door. She did not want this and stated numerous times that if he could not meet the repayments she would loose her home. Mrs Bedser went to see Mr Blackmore her solicitor at Merrylands and requested he change the deeds into her name so her son could not mortgage the home. Nothing was done.</p> <p>Mrs Bedser admitted that the deceased had a number of young men who worked for him.</p> <p>Mrs Bedser said that her son did not have money worries, he withdrew \$20,000 from his account for the holding deposit on the old home he wanted to buy, he did not use this. The money was put into a savings account. On a number of occasions the deceased told his mother that he was tired in the shop and wanted to sell it.</p> <p>She said that he was keen on his american cars and went with I35 to have a look at one to Melbourne.</p> <p>The deceased did not tell his mother that he was going to Melbourne, he told her he was going with I35 to Ulladulla, she was in her son's car and saw the airtickets in her son's bag on the front seat, she was very upset</p>
