	<p>About 4.25pm on 11/12/80, attended [redacted], re interviewed Mrs. Anne NOBBLETT and showed her the Identikit Photograph of the suspect. On viewing the Penry NOBBLETT stated the man she saw in BEDSERS' shop on the day before he was stabbed ie. 1/12/80, had hair similar in style to the Penry and that the nose was also similar.</p>	
	<p>She further stated that when she went into the store to buy the figurine, BEDSER was the only person in the store and as it was approaching 3.00pm BEDSER asked her to come back in a few moments times as he had to go to the bank. NOBBLETT left the shop and contacted her daughter from a public telephone box and then returned to BEDSER's shop and purchased a figurine. Upon entering the shop a man entered the shop in front of her and leant over and touched a child's rocking horse and said to Mr. BEDSER "They don't make them like this any more." BEDSER replied, "No. That's right. They don't do they. These were the good ones." This man continued to walk into the shop in front of NOBBLETT and again leant over in front of her and touched another object in the shpp which was near the counter. She later purchased her figuring and left the shop.</p>
